Premier Province of British Columbia

Premier David Eby got into public service to tackle big challenges and deliver results.

As B.C.'s Attorney General, Premier Eby got big money out of politics, cracked down on money laundering, took on opioid manufacturers, and reduced car insurance rates. Under his leadership as housing minister, thousands of homes are being built and hundreds of people experience homelessness are now in more secure housing.

Prior to politics, he was an award-winning lawyer and legal scholar. From 2009 to 2013, he ran the B.C. Civil Liberties Association as executive director.

Premier Eby remains grounded in the values he grew up with. He is a proud husband and father with two children, Ezra and Iva. He loves playing with his kids, practicing yoga and hanging out with his wife Cailey, a family doctor in Vancouver.

As B.C.'s 37th premier, he is working hard to build a better, stronger future for everyone.



KURT NIQUIDET

Vice President & Chief Economist Council of Forest Industries (COFI)

Kurt Niquidet joined COFI as Vice President and Chief Economist in May 2019. He also is an adjunct professor in the Faculty of Forestry at UBC.

At COFI, Kurt is responsible for economic studies, financial analysis of policy options, timber pricing, carbon modelling and other projects.

Prior to COFI, Kurt was at the Bank of Canada in Ottawa, where he was a Director within the International Economic Analysis Department responsible for global commodities and emerging markets. Kurt also spent several years as part of the Canadian Forest Service, leading a team of research economists, and lectured in Forest Economics at the University of Canterbury in New Zealand. He started his career as a forester for Makah Tribal Council in Washington state, and has consulted with forestry-related private and public organizations in B.C.

He holds a bachelor's degree in forestry from UBC, a master's degree in economics from the University of Victoria and a Ph.D. from the University of Groningen.

Previously, he was executive vice president and chief content officer at JOC Group, as well as a reporter, West Coast Bureau chief, editor in chief and publisher of *The Journal of Commerce*. Peter is the founder and chairman of the annual TPM (Trans Pacific Maritime) conference in Long Beach, California, one of the world's largest shipping events. He also led the development of the JOC Port Productivity data, the first global database of container port and marine terminal performance.

He is a columnist for The Journal of Commerce and JOC.com, covering a range of international logistics topics. He is a sought-after speaker for industry events and has been quoted in *The Wall Street Journal, Financial Times* and *The New York Times*.
