Ms. Exell received her BA from McGill University and Masters in Public Administration from the University of Victoria. She is a former president of the British Columbia Trade Development Corporation, a Crown corporation. During years of public service she also served as a member of the Royal Commission inquiring into workers' compensation in British Columbia.
