MEMBERSHIP FEES

Applications for membership are approved by the Board of Directors. Each application is considered on its own merits and guided by the following:

- > Representatives are willing and able to contribute to a strategic dialogue; and
- > participate regularly in the forum.

Benefits include an automatic seat on the Board of Directors, recognition of commitment in WESTAC materials and preferential access to opportunities.
